Special Issue: The Sensitivity of the Rorschach to Trauma

The Editorial Board of *Rorschachiana* is calling for submissions on the use of the Rorschach to assess the wide variety of trauma spectrum disorders, such as posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD), complex posttraumatic stress disorder (cPTSD), and developmental trauma disorder (DTD), and indications for treatment. In particular, the journal editors are interested in submissions that:

- (1) Address Rorschach specificities in various typologies of trauma;
- (2) Show the value of the Rorschach to resolve diagnostic controversies;
- (3) Address cultural differences in the experience and processing of various typologies of trauma;
- (4) Address differences among different Rorschach systems in the coding and interpretation of various typologies of trauma;
- (5) Use the Rorschach in the assessment of trauma in forensic settings;
- (6) Integrate Rorschach data with other instruments in the assessment of various typologies of trauma.

Research papers or case studies assessing the psychological effects of war and migration are also welcome.

The submission and acceptance process goes through two stages.

Stage 1: Submission of Proposals

Deadline January 31, 2024

Authors submit their proposals in English via email to the Guest Editors Nancy Kaser-Boyd (nkbforensics@gmail.com) and Anna Elisa de Villemor-Amaral (aevillemor@gmail.com).

The proposal includes title, author name(s), contact details, and a short summary (max. 1 page) outlining the topic, method, and results of the submission. The Guest Editors will screen the proposals for fit and potential suitability with the topic of the special issue.

Stage 2: Submission of Full Papers

Deadline June 30, 2024

Authors whose proposals were selected by the Guest Editors submit their final manuscripts in English through the journal's [online submission system](#). All submissions will undergo peer review.
