

## New additional editors in chief join the journal *Social Psychology*

Hogrefe Publishing and the editorial office of *Social Psychology* are delighted that Prof. Michael Häfner, PhD (Berlin), and Prof. Mario Gollwitzer, PhD (Munich), have agreed to join the journal on a temporary basis as additional editors in chief, starting in March 2024.

The term of office for Editor in Chief Prof. Anja Achtziger, PhD, was due to end September 2024. Unfortunately, due to circumstances over which she had no control, she has for some months now had to prioritize other duties at her university and has thus been unable devote the resources she would have wished to handling submissions, manuscript assignments and peer-review, and quality checks in the thorough and timely manner that a high-quality and high-impact journal such as *Social Psychology* requires.

Finding and appointing a new editor in chief is usually a process that takes some months or up to a year. Anja Achtziger and the publisher agreed that under the current circumstances *Social Psychology* cannot wait that long and so are delighted that Michael Häfner and Mario Gollwitzer have kindly agreed take on the bulk of the editor in chief duties until a new, longer-term solution is in place from September 2024 onwards. A call for nominations will, as planned, be released in the next few weeks.

We thank authors, reviewers, and readers of the journal for your patience and understanding in a difficult period. We hope you will continue to support *Social Psychology*, whether by submitting papers, providing peer-reviews, or serving as action and associate editors.
