Applications are encouraged from across the discipline of psychology, from all countries in Europe,

and from underrepresented groups. Individuals with either a quantitative or a qualitative research background are strongly encouraged to apply. It should be noted that these are voluntary, nonpaid positions. Your tasks will be:

- to handle annually up to 20 submissions for which you will be fully responsible. All submissions will be handled through the (comfortable) online submission system;
- to provide guidance and support to authors and reviewers in following the journal guidelines and abiding by high standards of ethics and publication integrity;
- to promote excellence in science and contribute to the development of the journal into a premier outlet for quality psychological research in all areas;
- to provide support and assistance to authors and reviewers in abiding by open science practices;
- to help shape and support the journal and develop the relationship with EFPA.

Associate editors can expect to serve a four-year term with the journal. The final selection will be made on the basis of both research excellence and fit with the research themes that the journal typically handles.
