**Special Issue:** Ten Old Inkblots, A Million New Technological Developments: New Frontiers in Rorschach-Based Psychological Assessment

**Guest Editor:** Luciano Giromini, University of Turin, Italy

The Editorial Board of *Rorschachiana* is calling for submissions on the use of new technological developments to improve the practice of Rorschach-based psychological assessment. In particular, we solicit submissions that focus on artificial intelligence, virtual reality, and other similar technological developments that could facilitate the administration, scoring, and/or interpretation of the Rorschach test. For example, empirical research on the administration of the Rorschach via videoconferencing or using speech-to-text technology, as well as research on the analysis of nonverbal indicators recorded during the administration of the Rorschach (e.g., sound waves, eye tracking, electrodermal activity, facial thermal variations, etc.) would be greatly appreciated. Theoretical contributions can be considered only to the extent that they provide important new insights based on empirically published literature.

The submission and acceptance process goes through two stages.

#### **Stage 1: Submission of Proposals**

Deadline January 31, 2024

Authors submit their proposals in English via email to the Guest Editor at [luciano.giromini@unito.it](mailto:luciano.giromini@unito.it). The proposal includes title, author name(s), contact details, and a short summary (max. 1 page) outlining the topic, method, and results of the submission. Dr. Luciano Giromini will screen the proposals for fit and potential suitability with the topic of the special issue.

#### **Stage 2: Submission of Full Papers**

Deadline June 30, 2024

Authors whose proposals were selected by the Guest Editor submit their final manuscripts in English through the journal's [online submission system](#). All submissions will undergo peer review. Author instructions are available at <https://www.hogrefe.com/us/journal/rorschachiana>

Accepted papers will be published in the second issue of *Rorschachiana* in September 2025. Papers may be published as advance articles before the publication in the issue.
